GAME RULES

GAME SCENARIO

You work for a medium sized law firm with 1000 staff. The firm handles client personal data including some special category medical data. You are responsible for the firm's data protection practices and have been asked by Senior Management to prepare for LOCS Certification.

To ensure a robust privacy framework and get the firm in the best possible shape for an audit, you must use your limited budget and time resources to best effect.

GAME SETUP

Sort the cards into their appropriate piles and give them a shuffle.

Give each player 100 Days and £70,000



PLAY

1 Each player must choose which of the technologies, processes and policies they are going to purchase before the game starts. They must spend at least half of their money and allocate half of their days.

2 Pick up 2 x Time Cards and 1 x Money Card

3 Take the top Event Card and carry out the instructions.

4 Optionally, trade in money or time to tick off items on the Score Sheet

Repeat for 12 goes (representing the 12 months you have to prepare for audit)

PENALTIES

If you are asked to use a certain amount of days and you don't have the time cards available you can either take **-5 penalty** in the RISKS table at the bottom of the Score Sheet or recover 50% of days spent by trading in one or more of the policies, records or processes that you had previously achieved.

If you are asked to spend an amount of money and you don't have enough to cover it you can either take **-5 penalty** in the RISKS table at the bottom of the Score Sheet or recover money spent by trading in one or more of your paid for technologies and getting 50% back.

After 12 turns take a **-5 risk penalty** for all missing tech, policies, processes and records.

AUDIT SCORE
